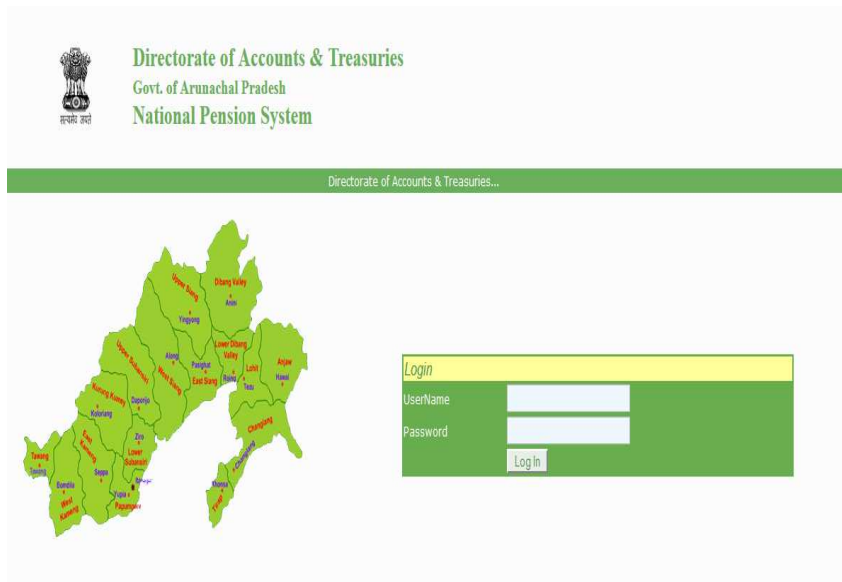


NATIONAL PENSION SYSTEM (NPS)

The **National Pension System (NPS)** is a defined-contribution-based pension system launched by the Government of India with effect from 1 January 2004. In Arunachal Pradesh, NPS is launched with effect from 1st January 2008 for State Government employee by Government of Arunachal Pradesh. Like most other developing countries, India did not have a universal social-security system to protect the elderly against economic deprivation. As a first step towards instituting pension reforms, the Government of India moved from a defined-benefit pension to a defined-contribution-based pension system. Apart from offering a wide gamut of investment options to employees, this scheme helps the Government of India to reduce its pension liabilities.



NPS computerization of Arunachal Pradesh is developed by National Informatics Centre (NIC), Itanagar for Directorate of Accounts and Treasuries, Itanagar. NPS computerization project is to

computerize the NPS accounts of Group A, B, C and D employees of Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh. The impact of the project is to monitor and quickly adjustment of missing credits/debits of the subscriber and faster delivery of annual NPS account statement.
