

Common Integrated Police Application (CIPA)

CIPA is a multilingual application to automate the processes (workflow) at primary sources of data itself e.g. Police Station and to build a crime & criminal Information system based on CrPC. It provides an efficient way of organizing crime records for generating queries/reports and crime analysis for decision support. The project is implemented at 41 Police Stations in Arunachal Pradesh.

CIPA uses open source software solutions with frontend as Java and backend as PostgreSQL. Under the project computers, laser printer, Multi Function Device, UPS, LAN have been provided in the police stations. Handholding support was provided by Technical Assistant. Training was provided to the police personnels in batches.
