

Standardisation of District Portals with Web CMS.

INTRODUCTION

India is a multicultural, multireligious country. It is divided into various State and Districts. District is the middle level administrative unit which co-ordinates with state and Union Government and provides various services to the citizens.

There are more than 600 districts in India and most of them have their own websites. Presently, district websites are designed, developed, and maintained by the respective District Administration with the help of Districts Informatics Officers (DIO) of NIC. This has resulted in use of different types of technologies, design layouts, and navigation architecture, At times, one need to visit multiple websites for different services. Hence there was the necessity to standardize the district websites and to bring uniformity in information dissemination, one stop single window services.

To cater to the need, a standardized district portal framework is released, which contains a solution towards e-governance for districts across the country with Odisha as pilot state. The standardization of district portal initiative is based on the content architecture of the National Portal of india (india.gov.in) under NeGP.

Standardisation of District Portals

The Portal

- ✓ Developed by using the technology-Linux, Apache , MySQL, PHP(LAMP).
- ✓ Adheres to OWASP security norms and Guidelines for Indian Govt. Websites (GIGW)
- ✓ Can also be used by persons with disabilities.

The content to the Portal is contributed through user-friendly web based content Management System (CMS) by the content Service Provider (CSP)/operator, in co-ordination with the designated Nodal officer of the District. The Content is further moderated and published by the DIO.

This process ensures the publishing of accurate and authentic contents and on time.

Features of the CMS

- ✓ Decentralised maintenance - The district officials will be able to upload and maintain the website from anywhere anytime 24*7 with NIC VPN.
- ✓ User-Friendly design with non-technical content authors in mind. Enables users with average knowledge of word processing to create the content directly.
- ✓ Configurable access restrictions - Roles and permission can be assigned that prevent editing of content by unauthorized users.

- ✓ Consistent design content stored is separated from design. The content from all authors is presented with the same, consistent design.
- ✓ Content Storage : Central storage means that contents can be reused in many places on the website and formatted for any device (web browser, mobile phone/WAP, PDA, print).
- ✓ A content framework (CF) which will cover all categories that should become a part of the District Portal. The CF would be structured to collect the following information.
 - District Profile
 - Administration
 - Who's Who
 - Profile of important Sector
 - Programme and schemes
 - Services (How do I ?)
 - Forms
 - Documents (optional)
 - Circular and notification
 - District Directories
 - Events, News & Announcements
 - Maps
 - Photo gallery
 - Important Links
 - Contact Us
 - Site Map /Search
 - Terms of Use
 - E-governance Initiatives
 - RTI
 - Disclaimer
 - Accessibility Statement.

Impact

This Portal brings uniformity amongst the district portals of the State and the Country. It caters to information needs

of a wide range of people in the state and the district. This portal is generic one which can be replicated in other states.

Implementation Status

Implemented in 14 Districts of Odisha. Ground work finished to implement in Arunachal Pradesh. Three districts in Arunachal Pradesh, namely, Upper Subansiri, Upper Siang and Lohit have setup the website. Other districts are being taken up for conversion to standardized portal.
